

# CRISP LEAF SPIREA

*Spiraea x bumalda 'Crispa'*

**Height:** 2-3'                      **Spread:** 4-5'

**Location:** Zone 4, sun to light shade

**Shape:** Rounded

**Foliage:** Red tinged, blue-green, crinkled, burgundy in fall

**Notes:** Pink flower clusters 3" wide. New growth is an attractive burgundy red. Flowers late June. If first blooms are cut, it will continue to produce additional blooms.



# GOLDEN ELF SPIREA

*Spiraea japonica 'Golden Elf'*

**Height:** 6-8"                      **Spread:** 18-24"

**Location:** Zone 4, sun for best color

**Shape:** Mounded, spreading

**Foliage:** Golden yellow

**Notes:** An incredible, dwarf spirea, great for rock gardens, borders and mixing into the perennial garden. This little yellow-leaved beauty only grows to 6-8" tall and has a spreading habit. It retains its leaf color through autumn, holding up in full sun and hot temperatures, and will bloom sporadically throughout summer.
