

# BLUE MUFFIN VIBURNUM

*Viburnum dentatum* 'Blue Muffin'

**Height:** 4-6'      **Spread:** 4-6'

**Location:** Zone 3, sun to part shade, tolerates wet soil

**Shape:** Compact, rounded

**Foliage:** Glossy green

**Notes:** A compact selection of Arrowwood Viburnum. In spring the plant is covered with beautiful flat-topped white flowers, then later in summer clusters of rich blue berries form. Fruit is striking against light green foliage which darkens to burgundy-purple in late fall.



# MOHICAN VIBURNUM

*Viburnum lantana* 'Mohican'

**Height:** 6-8'      **Spread:** 6-8'

**Location:** Zone 4, sun to part shade

**Shape:** Compact, rounded

**Foliage:** Thick, dark green, purplish red in fall

**Notes:** 'Mohican' was selected for its compact growth. Creamy white, flat-topped flowers cover the plant in late April or early May, followed by orange-red fruit in early July lasting a month before turning black in fall.
