

NORTHWOOD MAPLE

Acer rubrum 'Northwood'

Height: 50' **Spread:** 35'

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade, moist soil

Shape: Round to oval crown

Foliage: Dark green, red-orange in fall

Notes: The 1994 "Leon Snyder Plant of the Year", this selection from Northern Minnesota, and released by the University of Minnesota in 1980, has a rounded to oval crown with branches that ascend at approximately a 45 degree angle. Optimum growth, as with all Red Maples, will occur in moist, slightly acidic soil.
